Even though the rainy season has made our work a lot harder and we are facing a lot more problems than we already do anyway, we are thankful that this year it has not been raining constantly and so far we have been spared from huge flooding. We have taken in an uncountable number of injured and sick dogs and cats this month and many more have successfully been treated on the spot by our outside and Temple-Team. Of course not every case ends with a happy end like in the case of Dobby from BoPhut but it definitely helps to focus on such cases in order to keep going strong with our work in the future. Dobby was spotted near the main road by a great animal friend and reported to us. Dobby stayed with us for almost 6 months and made a remarkable recovery. It was a hard and often painful road Dobby had to take but it was all worth in the end. The person who contacted us about Dobby could not believe his eyes when he saw Dobby again at our shelter and decided to give (the already sterilised young dog) a home.
