Since opening our first cat café in Ban Taling Ngam, we have been able to rehome more than 10 cats from the shelter and attached café

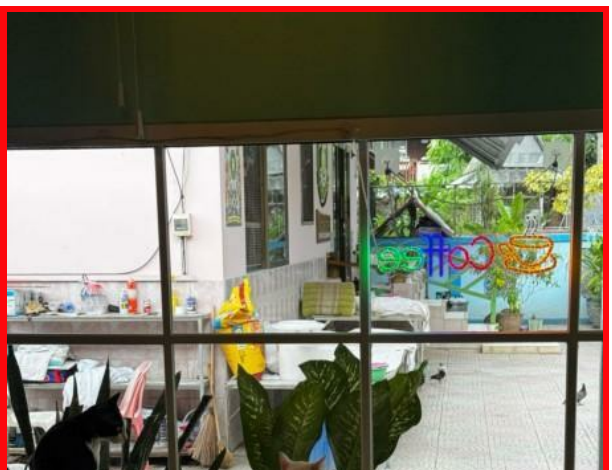
there, both overseas and within the UK. We anticipate a similarly large number of adoptions in Chaweng in the future.

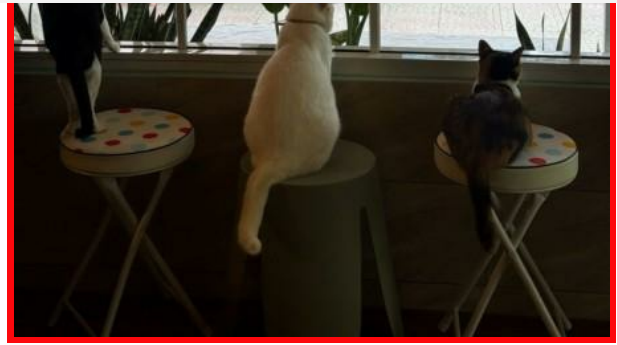
Here are the photos from the opening and our first visitors.

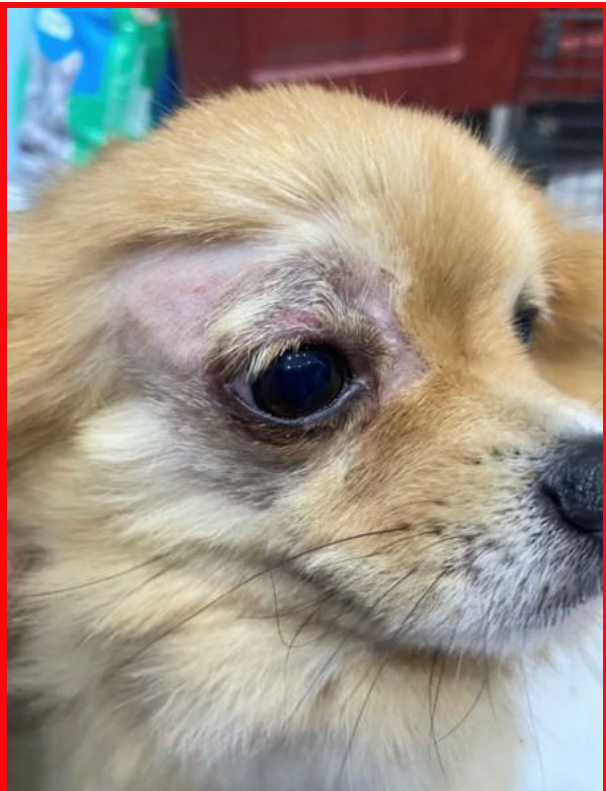
Students and veterinarians from all over the world come to us to learn from him and work with him!

We save countless lives of dogs and cats every day. Here are a few examples before and after treatment/surgery!

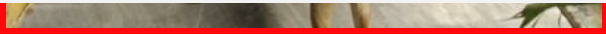




Many animal-loving visitors from all over the world found their way to us again to help and support us!

The treatment is extremely expensive, but without this medication, these furry friends will inevitably die.

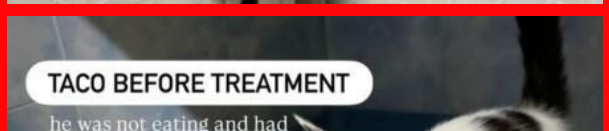

We recently had a parvovirus outbreak among our dogs, which was extremely expensive.

Unfortunately, three of our youngest patients did not make it, but we were able to save the lives of all the others thanks to high-quality medication and time-consuming treatment.

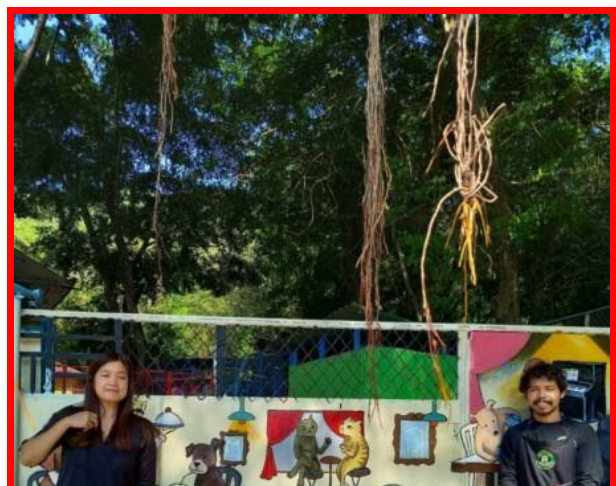

About us.
We are an official Non profit foundation set up by a small group of animal lovers back in April 1999. At that time there was no vet on the island and countless sick and injured dogs and cats died in wretched ways as they were completely ignored and left lying by the roadside. We employed a vet and a team of helpers and started with our neutering program. Since then and with the help of our animal friends from all over the world we've come a long way! 2024 marks our 25th year anniversary and by now we have neutered more than 35,000 animals and given a forever home to over 350 dogs and cats.

Dog and Cat Sanctuary
Open every day between 9 AM and 5:00 PM
In 2003 we opened our big dog and cat shelter in Ban Taling Ngam on 7200 M2 of land. We have an operation room, a puppy house with a quarantine station, a cat house, 10 outside compounds and 30 single boxes.



Come visit us at the big shelter in Ban Taling Ngam or at our office and small treatment station in Chaweng.
If you fall in love with one of the dogs or cats here we can help you to bring it home. Over the years, many of the dogs and cats at the shelter have been given a forever loving home abroad.



Cat House
We have lots of cats too. They all love to get spoiled and a visit at one of our shelters can be great fun, even with young kids. The animals in the house are very friendly and don't mind being carried around.



Every evening we throw a big fish party at our small shelter in Chaweng.

Temple Project
For almost 2 decades, we have been providing dog & cat food, vaccinations, and medical attention for the dogs and cats at many of Samui's temples.



Every day, we feed approximately 600 dogs and cats in the shelter, at the temples, and on the streets on Koh Samui. Therefore we need more than 5000 kg of food per month. 10 kg of dry food costs approximately 12 Euro.

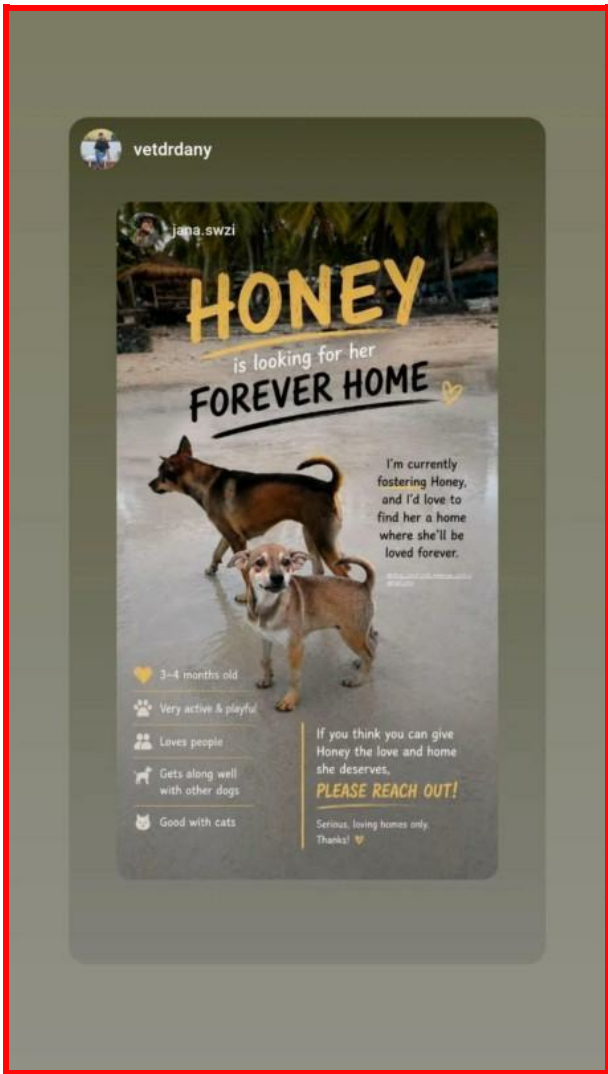

Please contact us, also if you would like to bring **serum for blood tests back to Germany!**

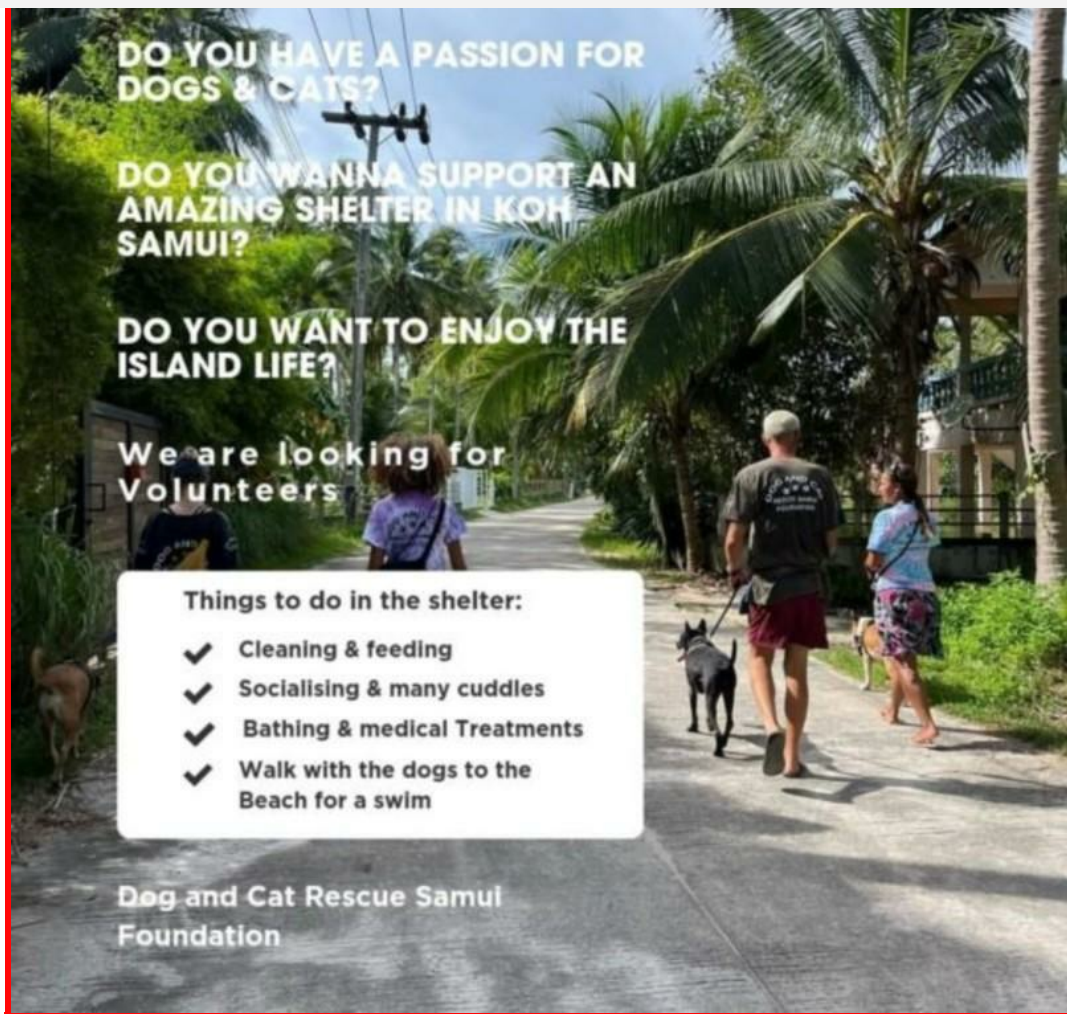




We also constantly need benches for the dogs. **The bamboo benches** unfortunately break very quickly, so we're now ordering some made of **solid wood**. One bench costs about 40 euros!

Despite the still outstanding donations from the old association Samuidog e.V.
(criminal investigations are underway against the board!),
we are again cooking daily (7 days a week) about 100kg of rice, 50kg of chicken, mixed with eggs, carrots and oil, for ALL our four-legged friends!

Everyone is warmly invited to meet the many wonderful dogs there.

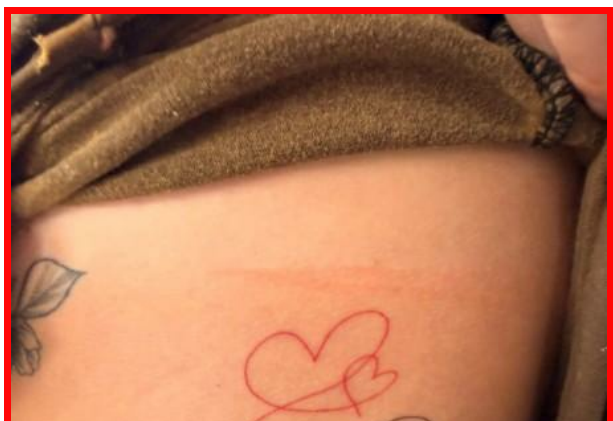
We've been helping out at the **landfill/incinerator** for many years now.
It's hard to imagine the conditions the dogs and people live in there!

In Chaweng, we have been offering the opportunity to the poor population to receive vaccinations and minor medical treatments for over 20 years. **T**

Temple Project: Sterilization, vaccination, feeding, medical care! Khun Wit, our president, is also the head of the temple project. He is in constant contact with the monks!



As always, we urgently need products like **Simparica, Nexgard Spectra, and Bravecto** to combat the many parasites, such as ticks, fleas, and mites (mange), for our projects both outside and at the animal shelter!

One pack costs about 35 euros, and we can treat an average of 9 dogs with it!

We help all over the island with food and medical care! Fortunately, we also have volunteers who regularly drive around the island to feed and check on their beloved animals.

We will continue to help on the mainland in the future, as I believe that our commitment to animal welfare **does not have to end at the borders of Samui!**

Thank you all for your ongoing commitment to animal welfare!

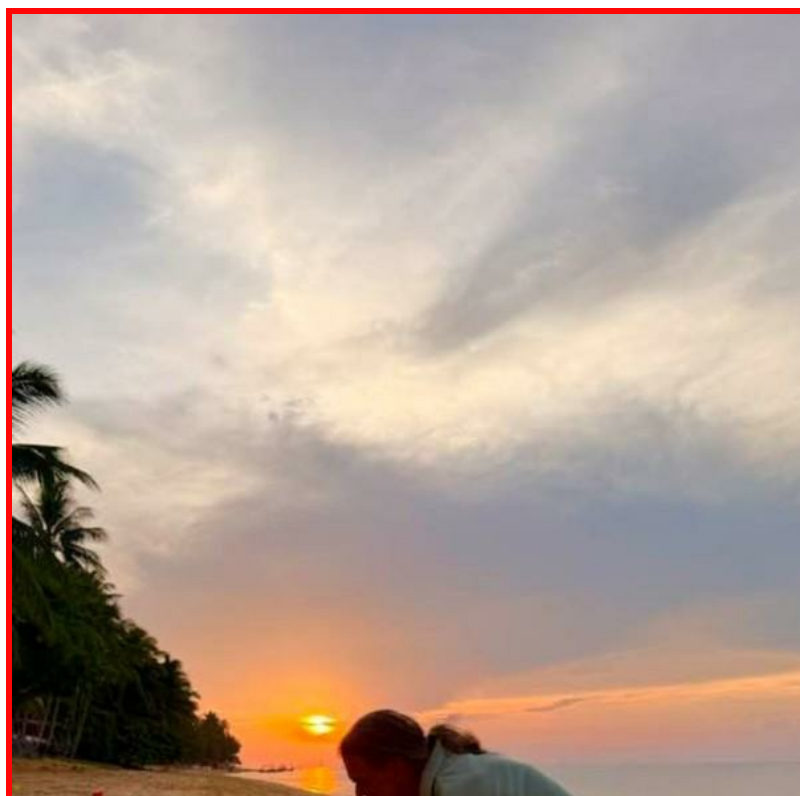
