Thanks to your help and support

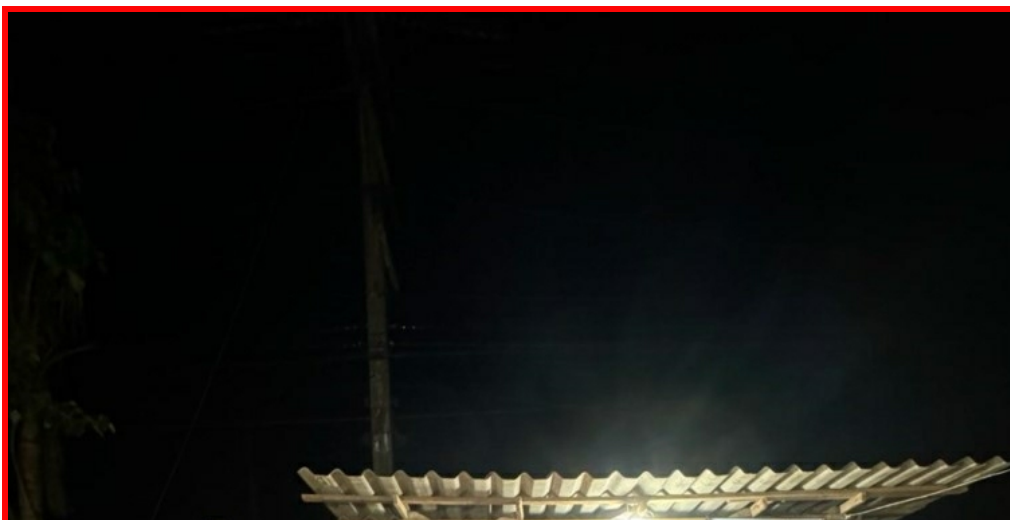

Here are photos of our little **celebration** with friends, employees and volunteers:

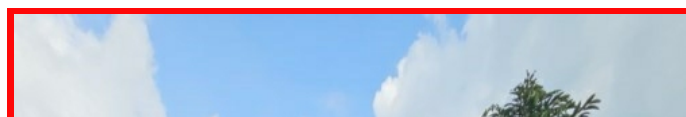




Great news about our huge water problem from the past.
Shannon Kerr from Canada covered the full cost of a deep well!
This includes the drilling for around €6500, the depth pump, the 9000l water tanks, another pump etc.
A total donation of almost €9,000!
The well delivers **14,000 liters per day** of crystal clear water every day from a depth of around 120m!
A big step into the future for our Foundation!!!



We all say thank you very much, but also our dogs and cats, here on behalf of Harvey & Peach!



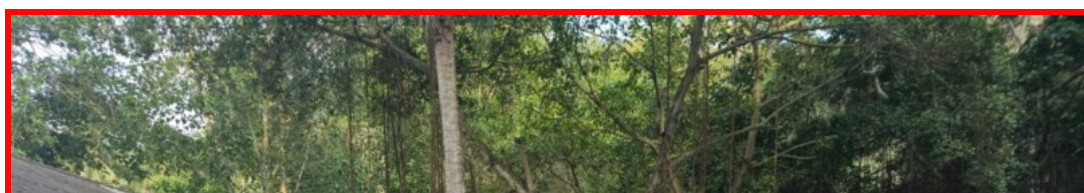

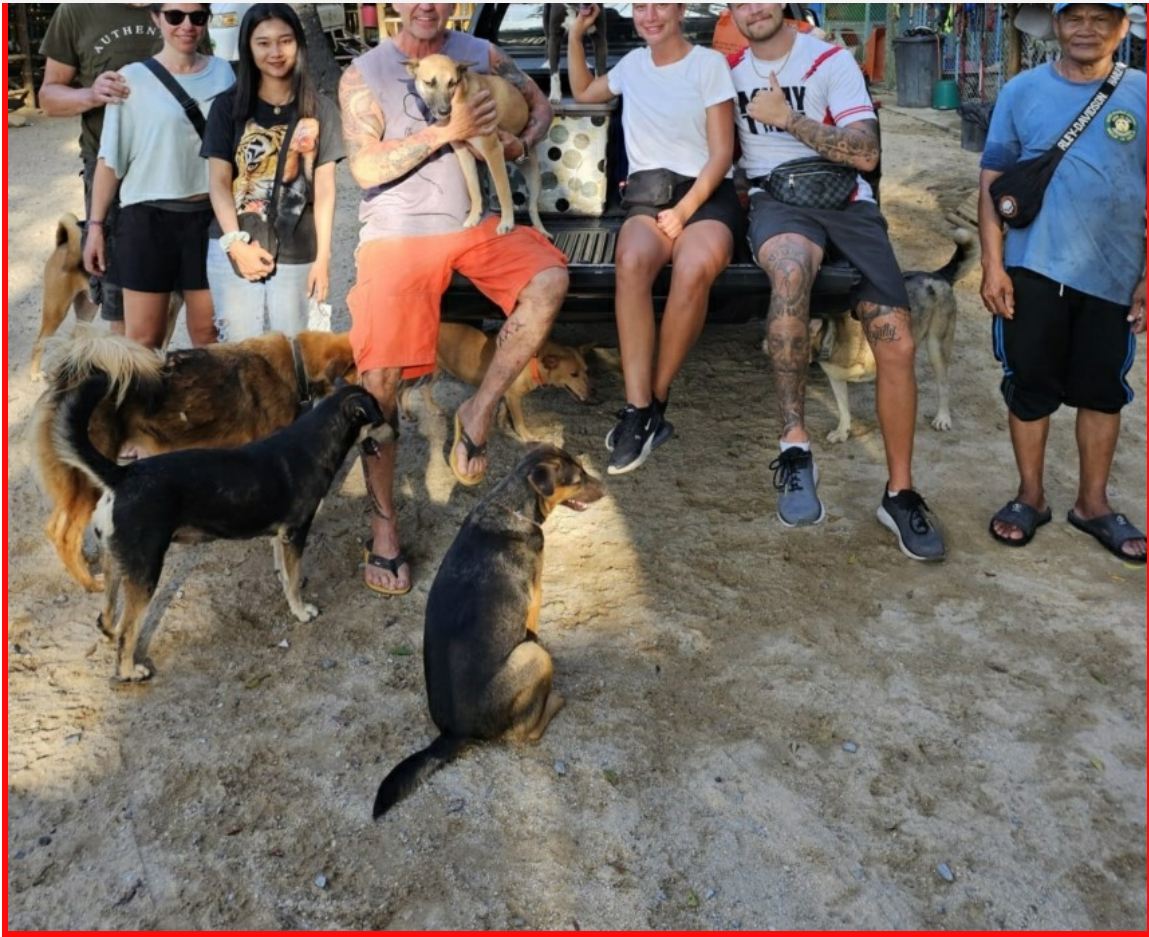

Many, many **volunteers** have found their way to us in the last few weeks and months to support us!

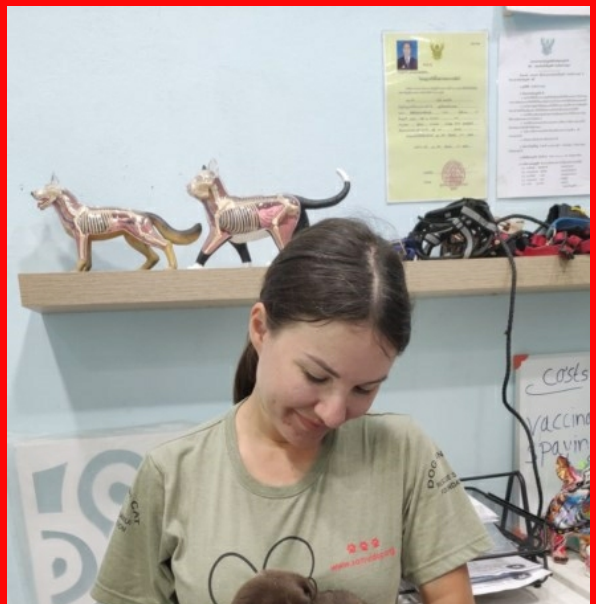
They all work on a voluntary basis to help the poor animals on Koh Samui.

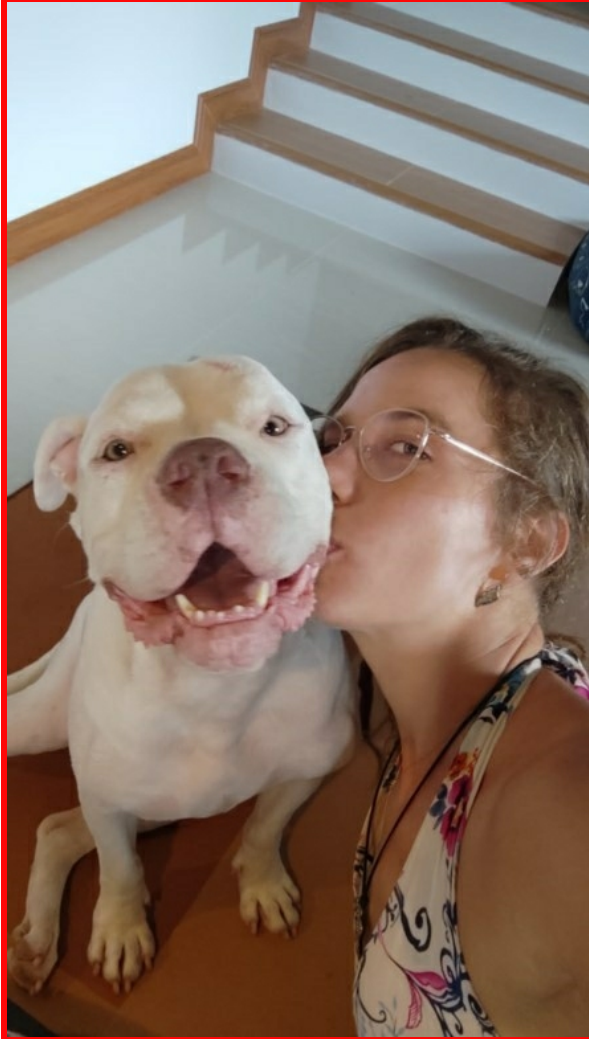
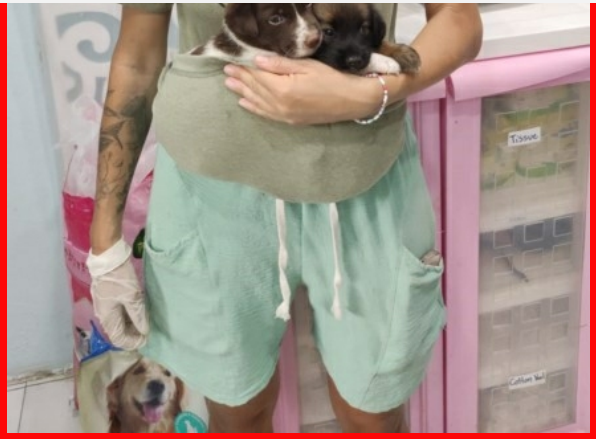
Our volunteer program has become an important pillar for our animal shelter

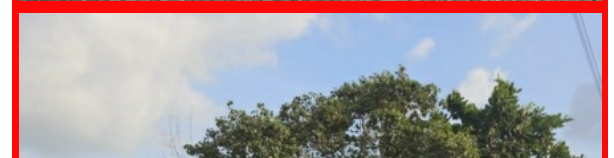
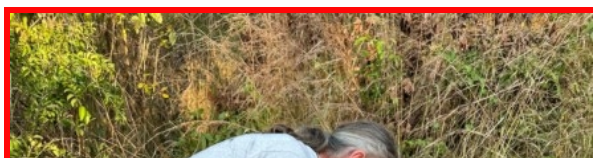
Here in the photos above, **Elena** (veterinary assistant from Germany), **Jane** from Russia and Tammi & Patrick from Germany

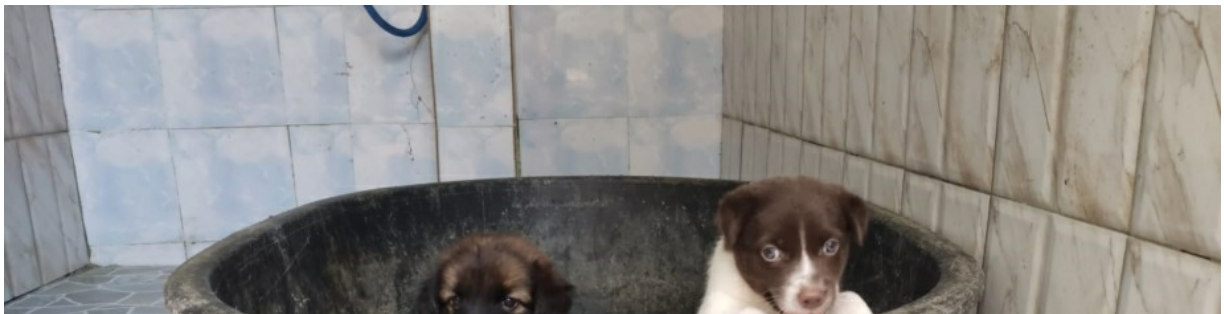

Unfortunately, despite the many castrations, puppies and kittens are still being born and they often end up with us.



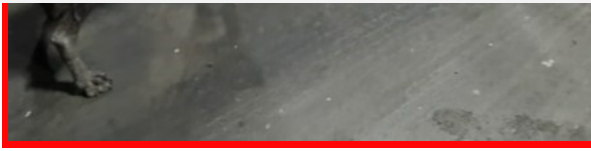


Of course, we continue to take care of the poor dogs at the **garbage dump and on the mainland in Don Sak**

Also big thanks to our volunteer **Katja from Neustrelitz** for her great time with us!

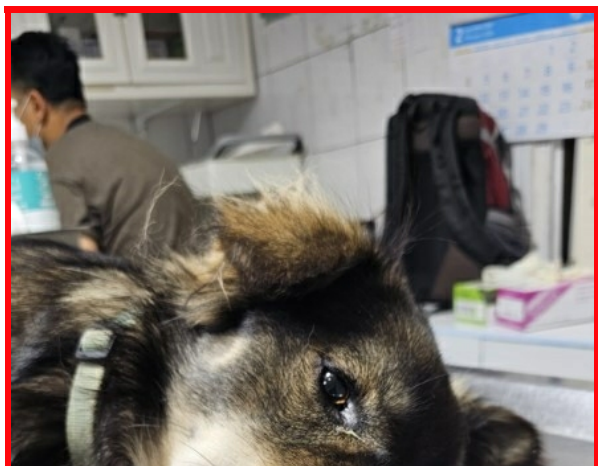
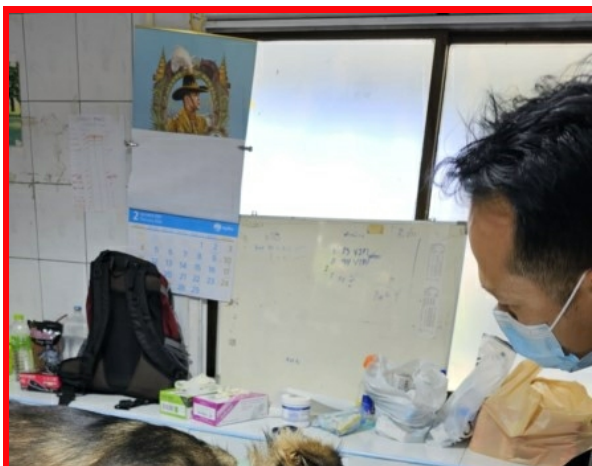


Here are some more news from our clinic: **Dr. Sid continues to work for us** and we have received the **license for our clinic for another 3 years** (You have to reapply every 3 years)

Life-saving surgeries every day!





It's great for our dogs and cats that many visitors from the island, but also from all over the world, find their way back to us.

Tourists, guests, long-time supporters and many friends

come almost every day to give our four-legged friends a cuddle and cuddle.

We are very happy about donations in kind, such as **food and collars as well as tools, building materials, etc. and financial support** so that we can pay for medicine, wages, food, etc.!

We are also very happy about (old) towels. So if you still have a few KG free on your trip to Samui, please fill your suitcases with them!!!

Visitors are welcome every day! **We are there 7 days a week** and are happy about everyone, who finds his way to us in Chaweng and also to Ban Taling Ngam.

The injury becomes more inflamed, the flies lay their eggs in it and maggots hatch.

These will eat the dog or cat alive if no help is given!





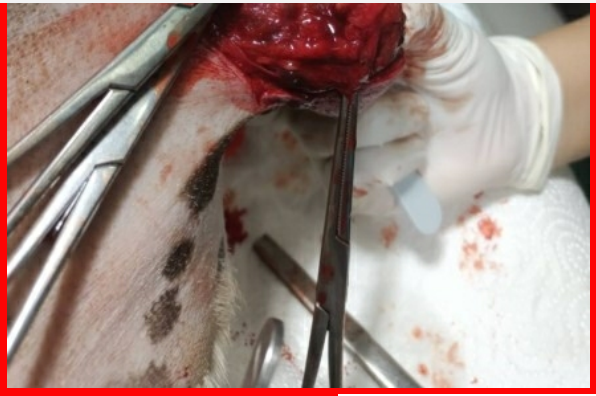
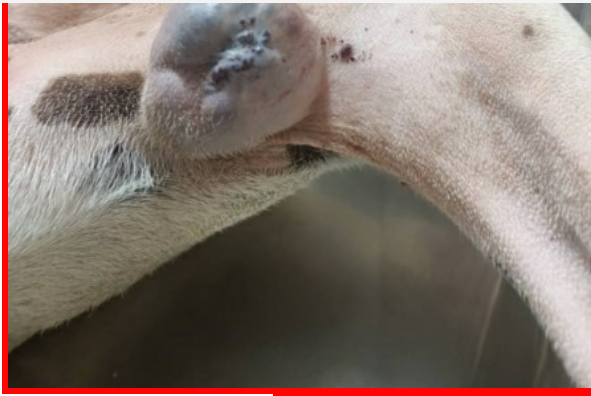
We always need **flight sponsors** to take our pets overseas to their new owners.

It's hard to imagine the conditions under which the dogs and people live there!

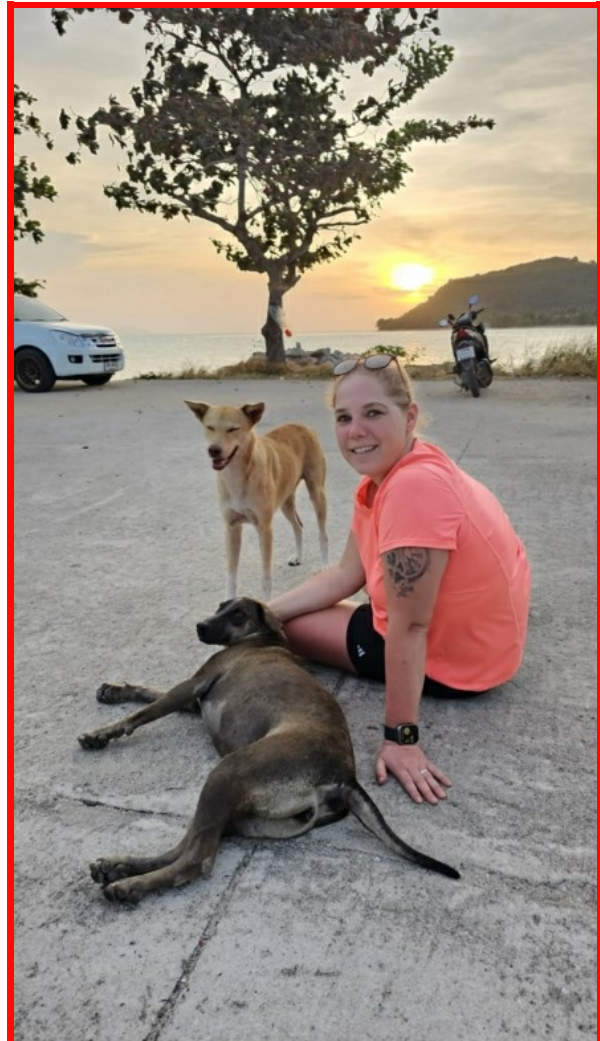

We help the poor population all over the island and support them with food and medicine.



We have been **supporting the temples on Koh Samui for many years** with food for their dogs and cats as well as with sterilizations, medical care, etc. We would like to thank the monks for their cooperation. Of course, our president **Khun Wit** continues to lead the temple project and is in contact with the monks, so that we can react quickly even in emergencies

There are many new cases of injuries, abuse, poisonings, accidents, etc. that we have to take care of every day



Here's an open fracture! **Dr. Sid** had to have his leg amputated immediately.

Thanks again to the many visitors who provided us here with food, Meds and financial etc. support.
Without them, the Foundation would hardly be able to survive!





We absolutely need remedies like **Simparica, Nexgard Spectra and Bravecto** against the many parasites, such as ticks, fleas and mites (mange) for our projects outside, but also in the animal shelter!

A pack costs around 35 euros and on average we can treat 9 dogs with it!

We help with food and medical care all over the island!

Luckily, we always have volunteers who drive around the island to feed and look after their pets.

We will continue to help on the mainland in the future as I think that our commitment to animal protection **does not have to end at the borders of Samui!**

Of course you can still use the account you know!

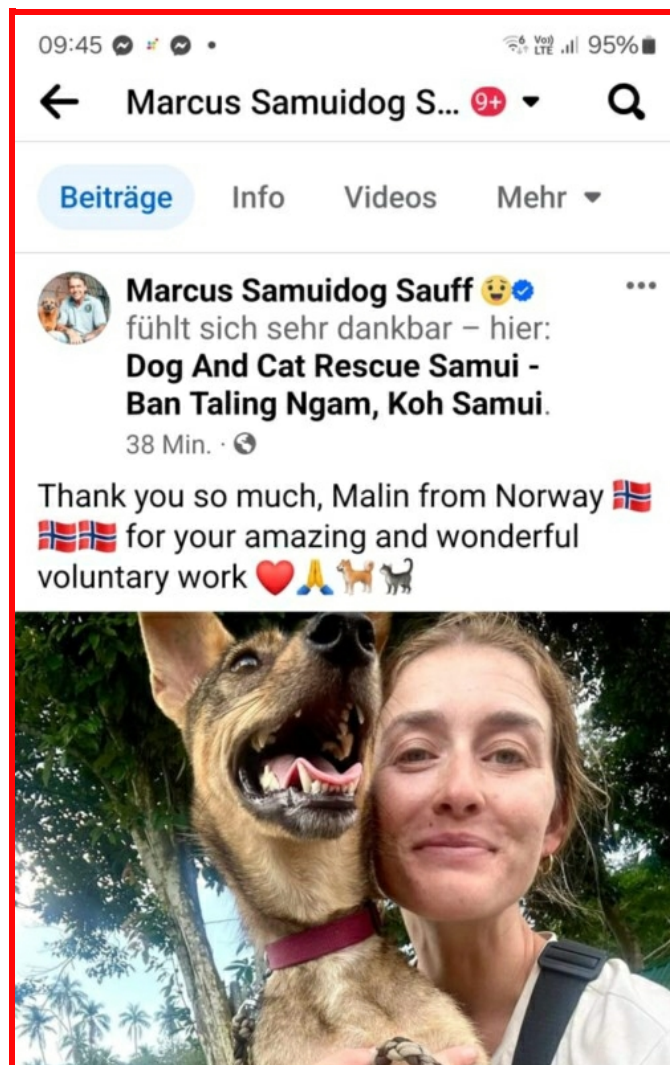

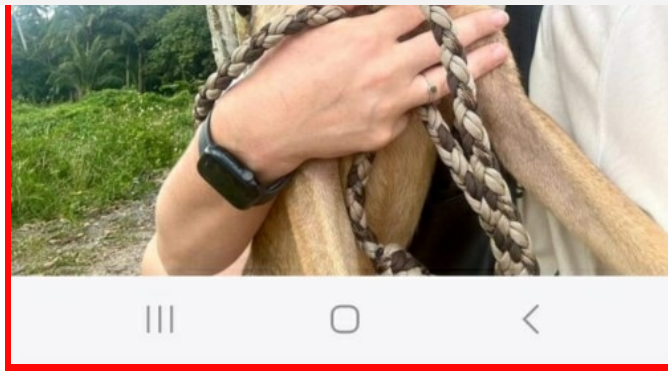
