Of course, as always, an important,


large pillar is our own veterinary clinic under the long-standing management of Dr. Sith.

as well as many other operations such as amputations, wound treatments, etc.


Students and veterinarians from all over the world come to us to learn from him and to work with him!



Great news: We have been able to build **a new, beautiful cat house in Chaweng**, measuring around 70 square meters! Our cats finally have a **little paradise** of their own there!





The 20-year-old cat house in Ban Taling Ngam is also due for renovation! The tiles have been broken for a long time and with the current rainy season in November, the water in the garden is so high that the cats can no longer get out.

We have to completely cover this area of around 100 square metres with roofs, re-concrete the floor and re-tile it.

If we can do the work with our workers, we expect the material costs to be around **4,500 euros**!

If we can raise a little more, we would invest the money in the **path to the street**, which is becoming more and more dilapidated, so that in some places it is almost impossible to drive in on a scooter.

Please help us so that we can start construction immediately! We are recognized as a non-profit organization in Thailand, as well as in Germany and Switzerland and can therefore issue donation receipts for the tax office!





They also receive vitamins, additional proteins and medicine if they suspect they have cat flu, which is unfortunately extremely common on Samui and almost no cat is spared from it..





We are always in need of **flight sponsors** , **flight volunteers** to bring our darlings to their new owners overseas.

Many darlings were able to fly overseas to their new homes. We are delighted that so many dogs and cats from and in **Germany**, **Switzerland**, **Austria**, **France**, **Spain**, **but also the USA and UK have found a new home**.

We also celebrated Halloween!










Here are some more insights into the work in our clinic

Our president Khun Wit is of course still leading the temple project and is in contact with the monks, so that we can react quickly even in emergencies





Thanks again to the many visitors who support us here on site with food, medicine, financial support, etc. Without them, the Foundation would hardly be able to survive!

We absolutely need products like Simparica, Nexgard Spectra and Bravecto against the many parasites, such as ticks, fleas and mites (mange) for our projects outside, but also in the animal shelter! One pack costs about 35 euros and we can treat an average of 9 dogs with it!

We help everywhere on the island with food and medical care! Fortunately, we also have volunteers who drive around the island to feed and look after their pets.

We will continue to help on the mainland in the future, as I believe that our commitment to animal welfare does not have to end at the borders of Samui!
