Koh Samui, October 2023

Dear friends and supporters Dog and Cat Rescue Foundation Samui!

First things first, a big thank you to all of you!

Without you it would Dog & Cat Rescue Samui Foundation doesn't exist and we couldn't handle the many hundreds of dogs & cats every day provide them with food and medicine, not to mention the many sterilizations & operations, which we do every day!

Over the last almost 25 years we have more than 30,000 strilized!

At least 5 cats and/or dogs get neutered every day!

Our next project: We absolutely have to build a deep well (about 200m deep)!

The water supply on the island is becoming more and more catastrophic!

The tap water is permanently turned off and we have to buy water!

In addition to the extreme financial burden, we often have the problem that the water is only delivered in the afternoon,

as private villas with pools are of course preferred.

But we, or our dogs and cats, need fresh water in the morning!

Of course we have to have **new pumps and large tanks for the well**, as we need around 8000 liters per day.

An area on our property must be concreted and roofed for this purpose.

Estimated costs: approx. 7,500 Euros

Many, many volunteers have found their way to us in the last few weeks and months to support us!


They all work on a voluntary basis to help the poor animals on Koh Samui.



Without you, the Foundation would hardly be able to survive!









We absolutely need remedies like Simparica, **Nexgard Spectra** and Bravecto against the many parasites, such as ticks, fleas and mites (mange) for our projects outside, but also in the animal shelter! A pack costs around **35 euros** and we can treat an average of 9 dogs with it!



Look at **Bobo**, who is through our treatment and Richard's love & care has become a **beautiful**, **healthy dog** again!







We help with food and medical care all over the island!

Luckily, we always have volunteers who drive around the island to feed and look after their pets.

We will continue to help **on the mainland** in the future as I think that our commitment to animal protection **does not have to end at the borders of Samui!**
