Unfortunately we cannot accommodate all four-legged friends on the island, hence our many projects at the many temples on the island, at the old pier in Ban Kao or wherever an animal is in need.

Every day we receive messages from injured or sick dogs, which we then pick up immediately or have brought to us for be able to have **Dr. Sith and his team treated!**

Thank you all again for making it possible for us to save many fur noses from certain death!

It is great for our dogs and cats that many visitors from the island,
but also **from all over the world**, find their way back to us.

Tourists, guests, long-time supporters and many friends
are now coming almost every day to give our 4-legged friends pets and cuddles.

We are very happy about donations in kind, such as **food and collars as well as tools, building materials etc. and financial support so that we can pay for medicine, wages, food etc.!**

Visitors are welcome every day!

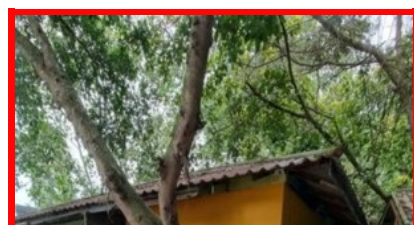
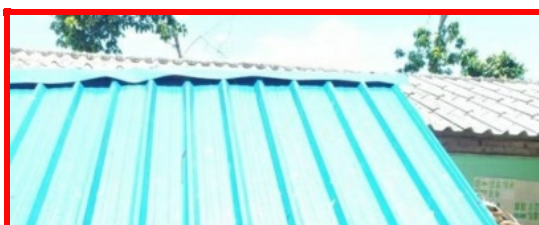
We are there 7 days a week and look forward to everyone

medication, food, leashes, collars, money, etc.







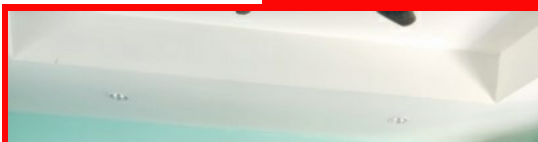
Great action by Beate & Daniel, who dragged a **huge duffel bag with towels** to Thailand!!!

We even get from some visitors/friends/volunteers help with feeding at our branch offices etc.

At the old pier of the Raja ferry in Ban Kao, we provide food (**we always cook fresh food for the darlings + dry food**) and of course medical treatment for about **160 dogs**.

Again and again new fur noses are released there because you know that we will take care of them.

Of course, we try to **neuter every newcomer as soon as possible**
so that there is no further, uncontrolled reproduction!
Our employees also go feeding strays on the streets outside of their working hours!
Thanks again to the many volunteers which we provide daily with free food!!!

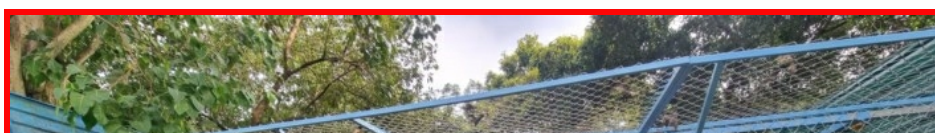


Unfortunately, snakes keep "straying" into our cat house, although we already have the walls over 5m high, reinforced with steel etc. Because **a python managed to get into our cat garden and killing 2 cats**, we had to act fast:

In consultation with Dr. Sith we have decided to seal off almost
the entire cat garden hermetically to **protect our cats!**

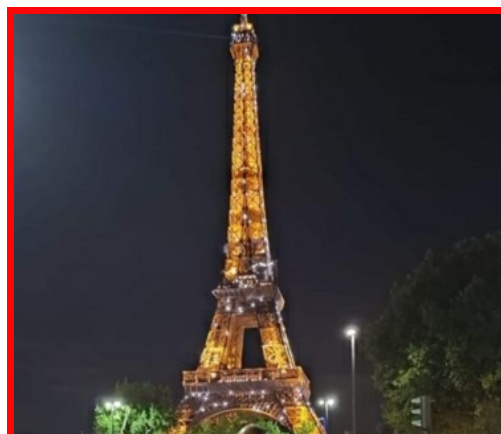
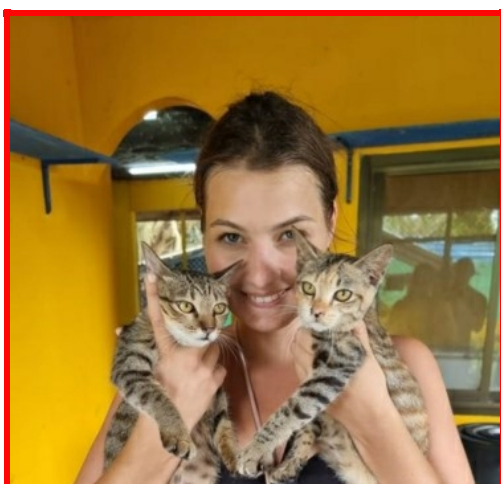

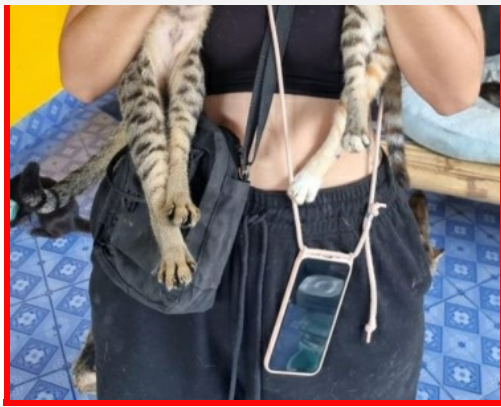




We are very happy that we were able to adopt some of our furnoses on the island, but also overseas.

In the first months of our cooperation **we have raised 30,000 baht.**

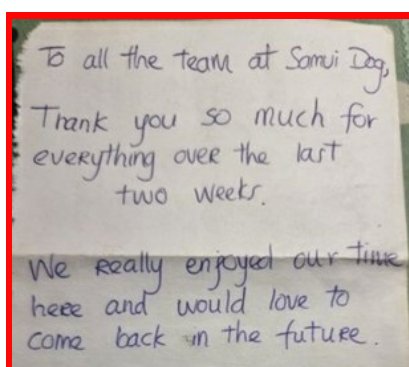
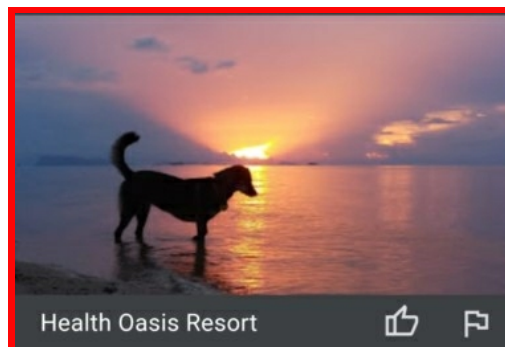
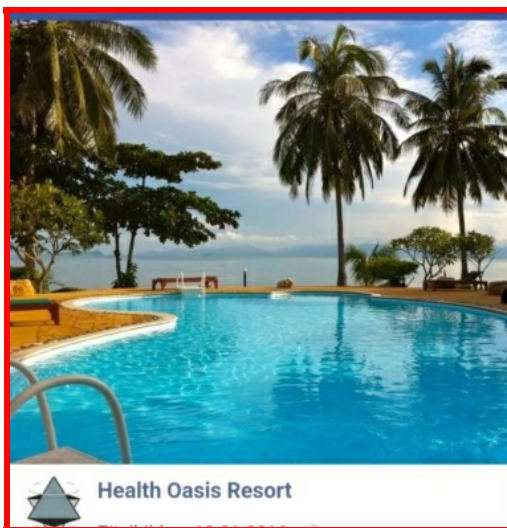

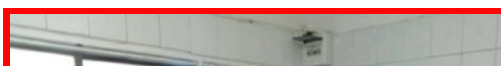


Thank you for your great commitment and good luck in your future profession as a veterinarian, **Gary, Anna, Emily and Chloe!**

About 4 weeks later full of enjoyment of his life

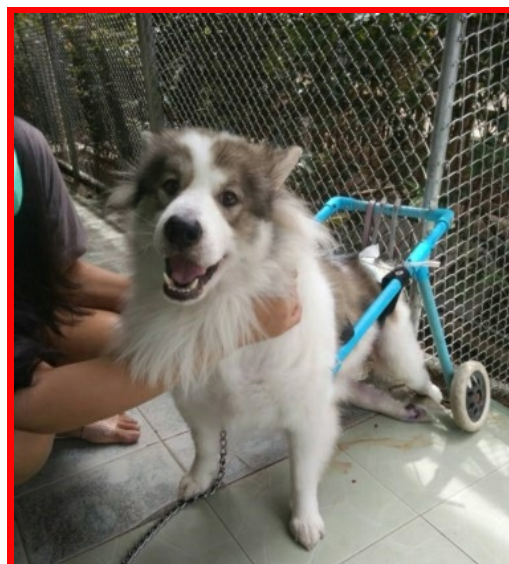


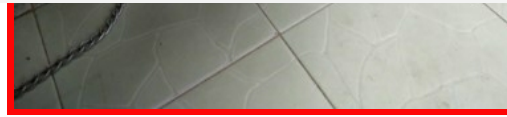
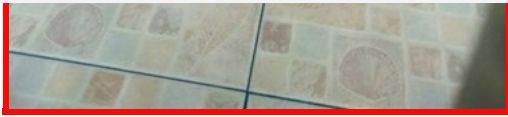
Unfortunately, many "owners" always come to us much too late,
