And of course, the ever-growing community of volunteers, students, helpers and many more from all over the world!





He is undisputedly a leading expert in the field of sterilizations. We perform **between 5 and 10 spays and neuters daily in our clinic**, as well as many other surgeries such as amputations, wound treatments, etc.

Fortunately, more and more short-term and long-term volunteers are finding their way to us.


This has become a major pillar of the Foundation and helps enormously improve the quality of life of our furry friends!








Thank you again to everyone for allowing us to take so many steps into the future to continue and better help the poor furry friends on Koh Samui!

And of course, to all the adopters on Koh Samui. A special thank you to **Christine and Detlef** in Bangkok for their many years of perfect cooperation!





















Hasse would then inform you about which cat or \log doesn't yet have a sponsor.


















Many beloved pets were able to fly overseas to their new homes.

We have been **supporting the temples on Koh Samui** for many years, providing food for their dogs and cats, as well as sterilizations, medical care, and more. We sincerely thank the monks for their cooperation.

We cook 100 kg of rice and 80 kg of chicken every day, mixing it with carrots and oil. One of our staff members has to come every day, 7 days a week, at 7 a.m. to put the rice on the stove, because it takes until the afternoon to cool down.









We urgently need medications like **Simparica, Nexgard Spectra**, and Bravecto to combat the many parasites, such as ticks, fleas, and mites (mange) for our projects outside, but also at the shelter!

One pack costs about €35,and we can treat an average of nine dogs with it!

We help all over the island with food and medical care!

Luckily, we also regularly have volunteers who travel around the island to feed and check on their beloved animals.

We will continue to help on the mainland in the future, as I believe that our commitment to animal welfare doesn't have to end at the borders of Samui!
