First things first, a big thank you to all of you!

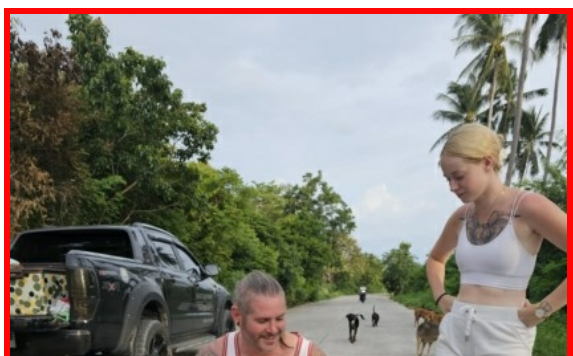

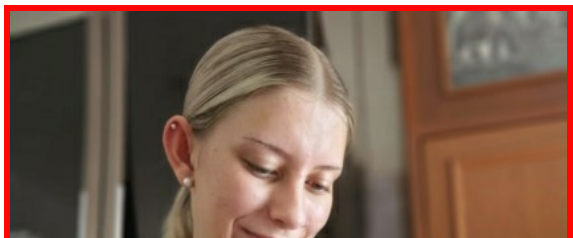
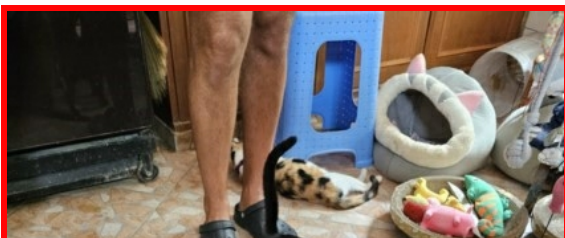


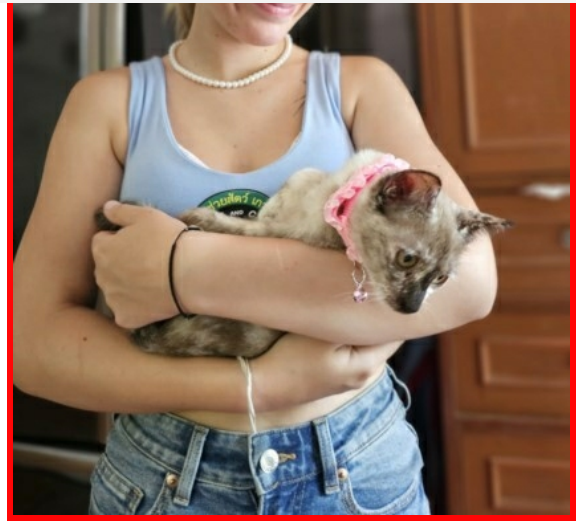
Many thanks to the **many visitors, friends, supporters and helpers**, who have found their way to us again!

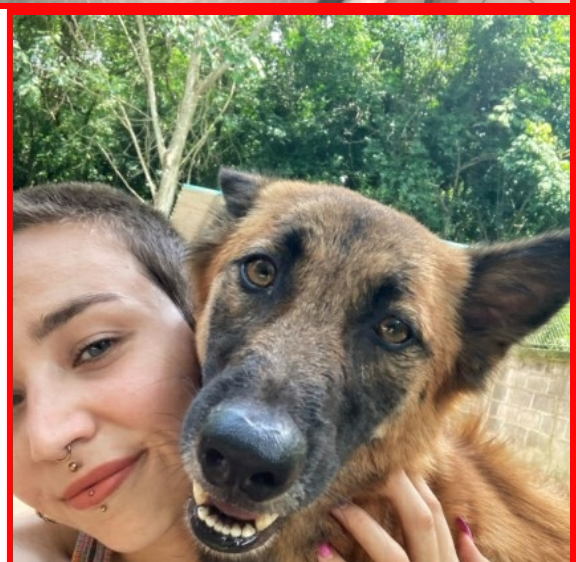
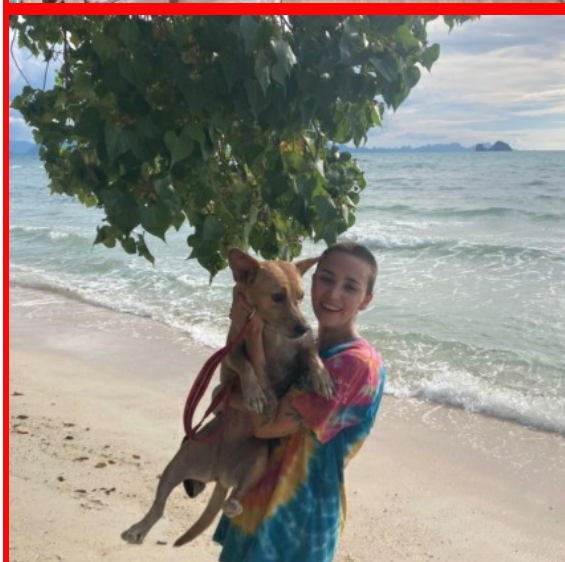


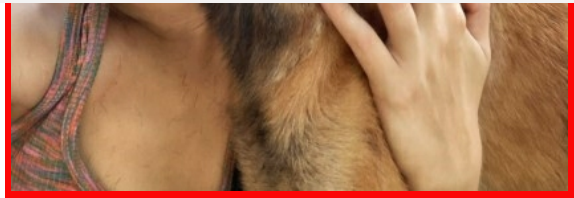
Many, many **volunteers** have found their way to us in the last few weeks and months to support us!

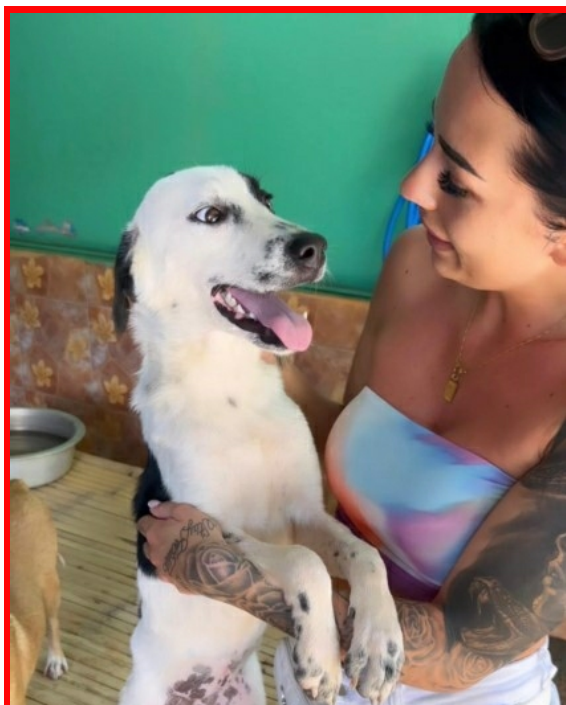

I would also like to especially thank **Pam from Australia**, which supplies us with wet food for our dogs and cats all year round!

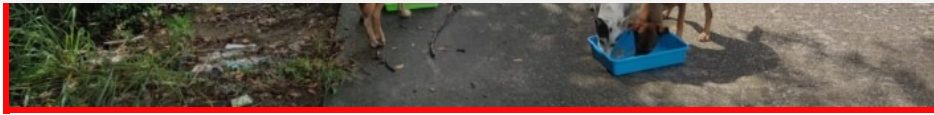

Jacky was with us for 4 weeks and was a great help in Chaweng and Ban Taling Ngam!

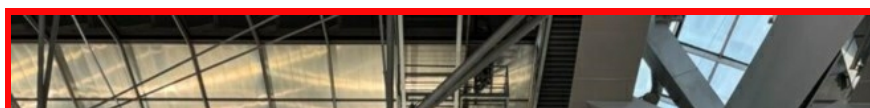

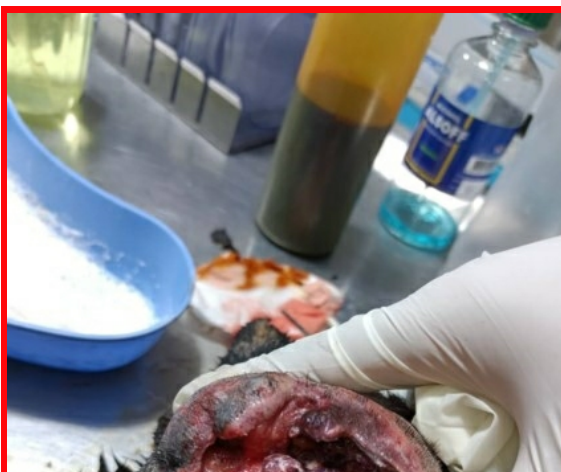

We have great new T-shirts and cool caps.

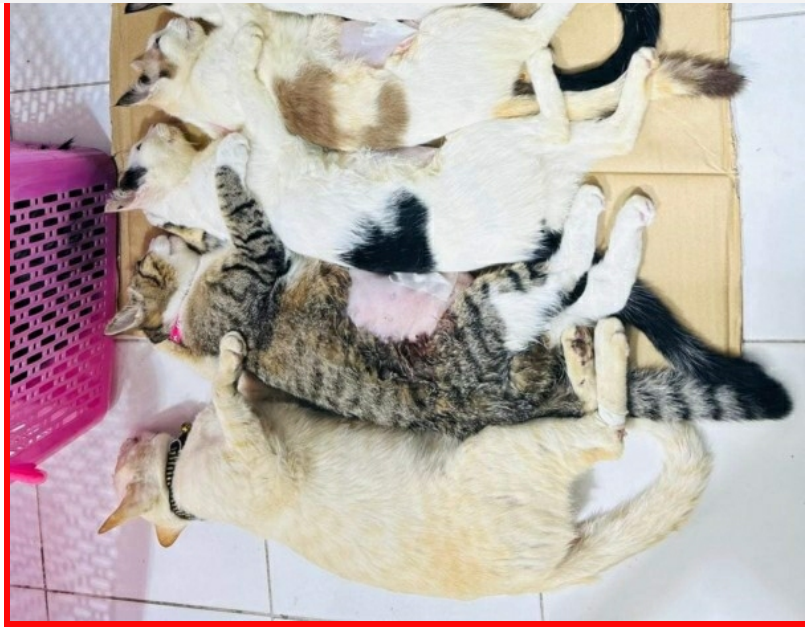

We also sterilize your pets for free





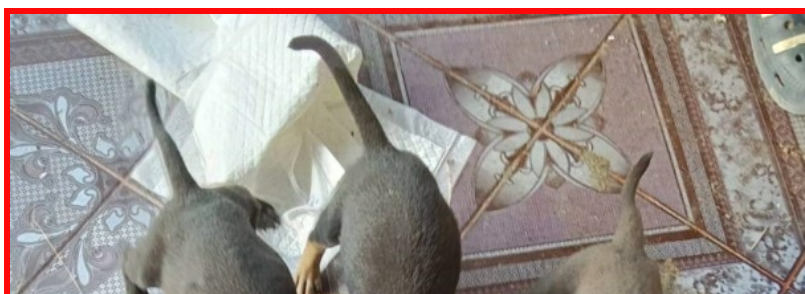
Many of our cuties find a **new home abroad**

There are many new cases of injuries, abuse, accidents, etc. every day that we have to take care of.

Of course, I would like to spare you photos of poisonings, amputations and all other forms of abuse here in the newsletter!





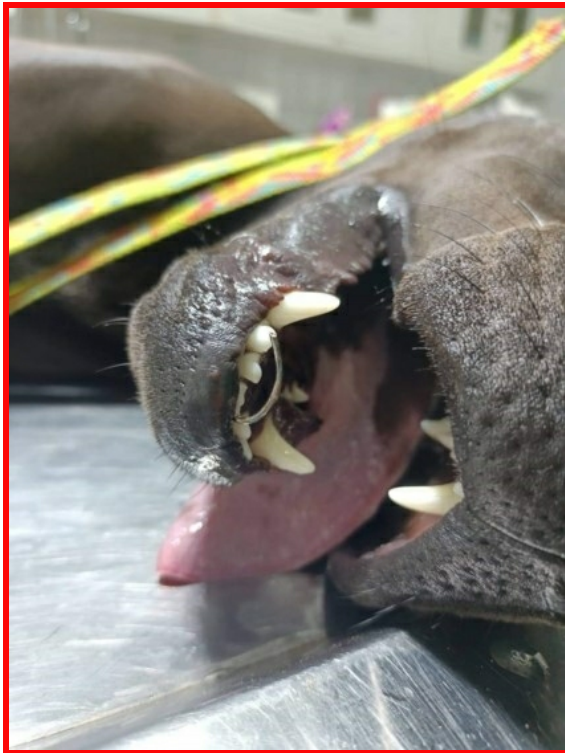
Thanks also to the many visitors who provided us here with food, Meds and financial etc. support. Without them, the Foundation would hardly be able to survive!

We absolutely need remedies like **Simparica, Nexgard Spectra and Bravecto** against the many parasites, such as ticks, fleas and mites (mange) for our projects outside, but also in the animal shelter!
A pack costs around 35 euros and on average we can treat 9 dogs with it!



We help with food and medical care all over the island!
Luckily, we always have volunteers who drive around the island to feed and look after their pets.

We will continue to help on the **mainland** in the future as I think that our commitment to animal protection **does not have to end at the borders of Samui!**

There **I post daily current articles** about the Dog Rescue Center and the island of Koh Samui.
Here too, unfortunately the costs for food, medicine, electricity and petrol are increasing almost daily!
Please remember that the poor dogs and kittens almost always only have us and wait all day for their food ration and a few cuddles!

A 20 kg feed bag costs around 20 euros! This is our ration for about 3 week
