Still a little under shock, we have to now face the fact that we are no longer in the financial position to provide the same free service as in the past.

We are now forced to charge for medication (which will still be much cheaper than any other private vet clinic and will be calculated and charged by our vet).

For sterilisation/castration we will now have to take a fix amount of 500 baht. Vaccinations cost 100 baht.

However, if you are not able to afford any of the treatment, please discuss it with our vet and surely we can find a solution.

If you come to the DRCS with a stray animal, of course you will not be charged.
