Dear Animal Lovers on Koh Samui,

February 2012

We've had several visits from international TV-reporters over the last few years and documentaries about the Dog and Cat Rescue Center Samui have been broadcasted in Germany, Switzerland, Sweden, South Africa and probably in many more countries. Last week, Jan from Germany and his camera man from Bangkok came to visit and accompanied us for one day. Most of us have gotten used to being interviewed and already know what a day of filming involves. Werner and I have gone through so many interviews already, no camera light can make us nervous anymore. It turned out to be a packed full day and we believe Jan got what he was looking for. They first made sure that the viewer gets a good impression of how things work at our main shelter in Baan Taling Ngam (it most probably will be broadcasted during a Breakfast-Show in Germany), followed by a shooting on the beach, where our manager Wit, our volunteers Bärbel and Günter and Ronia and Tatiana picked up a sick dog after we received a phone call from a worried resident.

After the action on the beach, they went along with our Temple-Team to Wat Chaeng, where Jay and Linda delivered dog and cat food to the monks, had some pretty nasty wounds to clean, puppies to vaccinate and much more. For someone who is not used to the surrounding of the temples, it must have looked quite amazing how all those temple dogs (at least 25) came running over as soon as the DRCS-car drove in. Even injured animals came over straight away and 'showed' the Team where help was needed. Also the monks were very cooperative in front of the camera and showed their appreciation.



Any kind of awareness work helps us to get more people interested in our work and eventually more people supporting us with their donations. Whether it is food donation, medicine, old towels/bed sheets or support through a helping hand at the shelter; we appreciate any kind of support and will continue doing as much awareness work as we possibly can.
