Dear Animal Lovers on Koh Samui,

January 2009

Since October 2007 we feed dogs and cats at various different temples around the island. In April 2008, our dedicated long-term volunteers; Janine, Linda and Kelli, have made it their goal to make this project work, and to stress the importance of their work to the monks as well as to everyone who cares to listen. They have taken the temple project under their wings, and now visit more than 15 temples around the island.



On average per month, Janine, Linda & Kelli give 120 injections for mange, 20 contraception injections, (this works the same as in humans & is an effective short term means of birth control), 40 vaccines, 110 puppies & kittens are de-wormed, as well as some adult animals, 30 incidents of wound cleaning, (this can be a result of a bite or a car/motorbike accident), and 10 dogs are taken to the shelter for spaying /neutering in a continuing effort to control Samui's animal population. Every month the DRCS provides 500kg of dog food and 30kg of cat food for the animals at the temples. We really need everyone's support to keep this project alive. Hotels/restaurants can donate food or make a monthly monetary donation and the people of the island, tourists and residents alike, can help us help with a donation.
