Unfortunately there are plenty of cases like Ludwig on the island and people often don't realize how easy it can be to change a dogs life and make that fur grow again. In only a few weeks Ludwig changed from being almost hairless to a pretty stunning looking dog. All it takes is one injection a week over 3-5 weeks. In many cases one or 2 injections can already be enough. It is also

possible to give the medicine in food, which often makes the treatment a lot easier. If you see a mangy dog or perhaps your own dog has this problem, please do not hesitate to contact us! Let's help those dogs to get their fur back and stop that never-ending itching feeling!
