March 2012

Don't forget our 13th anniversary party! Come and celebrate with us on the 1st April at our shelter in Baan Taling Ngam, 2pm - 6pm! Everybody is welcome to have a snack and a drink with us and check out our shelter with our Puppy- and Cat House, and over 10 outside compounds. Come and find out for yourself, what we've been doing in the last 13 years....

We made about 15 000 castrations of cats and dogs (6 every day). We also did about 50 000 rabies injections, because of this the government declared Koh Samui rabies free in 2002! 4 years ago we started the temple programme. This means where treating and feeding cats and dogs at nearly all of the temples.

Meanwhile the monks inform us when the cats and dogs need help, and some even give the medicine to the cats and dogs themselves!

Thousands of dogs and cats got mange and wound treatments. There is FREE treatment available for all cats and dogs on the island!! We already had a lot of people make use of this to help their cats and dogs. Many of the poor Thai people would not have the money or the means to help their own animals if they would go to a normal vet. So they always can come to us!!

We helped hundreds of people with the transport of cats and dogs to their home country because they fall in love with these cute animals.

Since last November the DRCS is an official Foundation, but other than the name, nothing has changed. We are now called the Dog and Cat Rescue Samui Foundation.

A big Thank you to the Sisters of Samui (SOS) for their great support! Sue will hand us over a cheque of 50,000 so that our half broken car can finally be repaired, THANK YOU SO MUCH!
